

This follows comprehensive community consultation undertaken by the NSW Department of Education in the Georges River school communities to better understand parent and student decision-making regarding high school enrolment choices.

The consultation found strong support for co-educational options, particularly among future parents.

In 2025 the school will become co-educational in Years 7 and 8. Years 9 and 10 will become co-educational in 2026. Care will be taken in the transition to ensure all students are well supported during the changes.
